## Day 1 - Arrival in Paro & Cultural Immersion

Thu, 12th November 2026

Welcome to the Kingdom of Bhutan!

Your journey begins at the enchanting Paro International Airport, where you will be greeted by your dedicated guide and driver. Depending on your arrival time, enjoy a delicious lunch at a favorite local restaurant. Your afternoon is filled with heritage as you visit the National Museum of Bhutan and the iconic Paro Rinpung Dzong, a fortress-monastery overlooking the valley. After checking into the Jewel Heritage hotel, you will have a briefing session with your road captain to prepare for the exciting ride ahead. The day concludes with a warm dinner at the hotel.

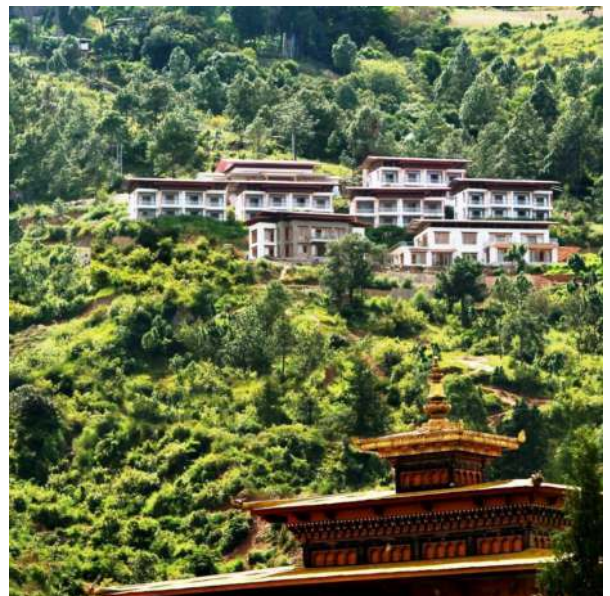


## Day 2 - Scenic Ride to the Haa Valley

Fri, 13th November 2026

After breakfast, embark on a 4-hour, 105 km ride to the remote Haa Valley via the Paro-Chuzom-Haa highway. This journey offers a first taste of Bhutan's winding mountain roads. Treat your palate to local Haa delicacies and enjoy a traditional lunch at a local family farm home. The afternoon is dedicated to riding around the serene Haa Valley, soaking in the quiet rural atmosphere before checking into Sonam Zhingkhram Lodge for dinner and rest.

### Day 3 - Giant Buddhas & National Treasures in Thimphu

Sat, 14th November 2026

Today's 109km ride takes you to the capital city, Thimphu, via the high-altitude Chelela pass. After a 4-hour journey, refuel with lunch at the Babesa Village Restaurant. Your exploration of Thimphu includes a visit to one of the world's largest sitting Buddha statues, offering panoramic views of the valley. You will also visit the Royal Takin Preserve to see the Takin, Bhutan's unique national animal. As evening approaches, enjoy a wander through Thimphu's main district center before retiring to the City Heritage hotel for dinner.

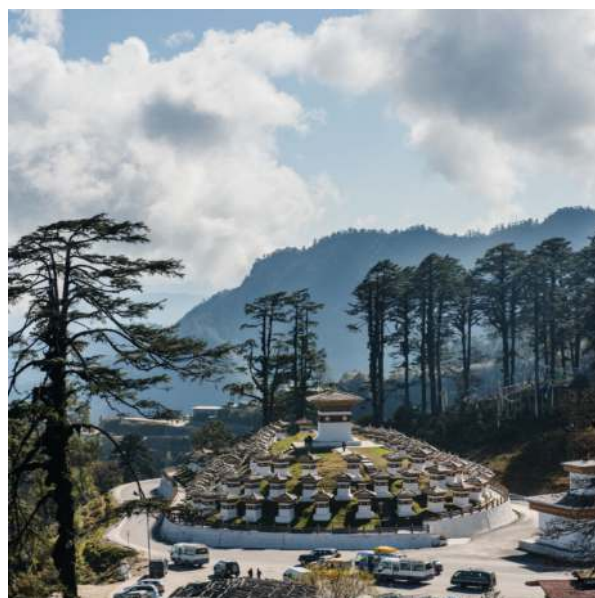


### Day 4 - Dochula Pass to the Gangtey Valley

Sun, 15th November 2026

Leave the capital behind for a 124km ride to the glacial valley of Gangtey. The highlight of this 4-hour journey is the stop at Dochula Pass (3100m), where you can witness breathtaking Himalayan views and find solitude in the serene meditation caves. After lunch at Ku Kham House, continue to the Gangtey Valley for an afternoon ride through its wide, marshy plains. You will spend the night at either Dewachen or Pinewood Resort, nestled in the heart of this stunning conservation area.

## Day 5 - The Spiritual Heartland of Bumthang

Mon, 16th November 2026

Today features a 5-hour, 163km ride to Bumthang, the spiritual heartland of Bhutan. En route, stop for lunch at the picturesque Willing Waterfall Cafe. Upon reaching Jakar, spend the afternoon exploring the town and its historic sites. This region is famous for its ancient temples and unique traditions. Check into the Jakar Village Lodge for a restful evening and dinner at an elevation of 2800m.

## Day 6 - Descent to Punakha Valley

Tue, 17th November 2026

Prepare for a longer 6-hour ride covering 215km as you head towards the lush, subtropical Punakha Valley. After enjoying lunch at a local restaurant along the way, you will visit Chimmi Lhakhang, the famous 'Fertility Temple' dedicated to the Divine Madman. The day ends with check-in and dinner at Hotel Zen in Punakha, located at a much warmer altitude of 1200m.

## Day 7 - Return to Paro

Wed, 18th November 2026

Begin your morning by exploring the architectural splendors of Punakha Dzong, arguably the most beautiful fortress in Bhutan, situated at the confluence of two rivers. Following the visit, embark on a 3.5-hour (115km) ride back to Paro. After a roadside lunch, take some time to stroll through Paro town for last-minute souvenir shopping or local interaction. You will return to the Jewel Heritage hotel for dinner and your overnight stay.

## Day 8 - The Legendary Tiger's Nest Trek

Thu, 19th November 2026

The penultimate day of your journey is dedicated to Bhutan's most iconic landmark. A short 20-minute transfer takes you to Ramthangkha, the base for your trek to Paro Taktsang, or 'Tiger's Nest' monastery. The 3-hour ascent to 3120m offers incredible views of the monastery clinging to the cliffside. After descending, enjoy a final traditional lunch at a family farm home. The evening features a special farewell dinner at the hotel to celebrate the completion of your Bhutanese adventure.

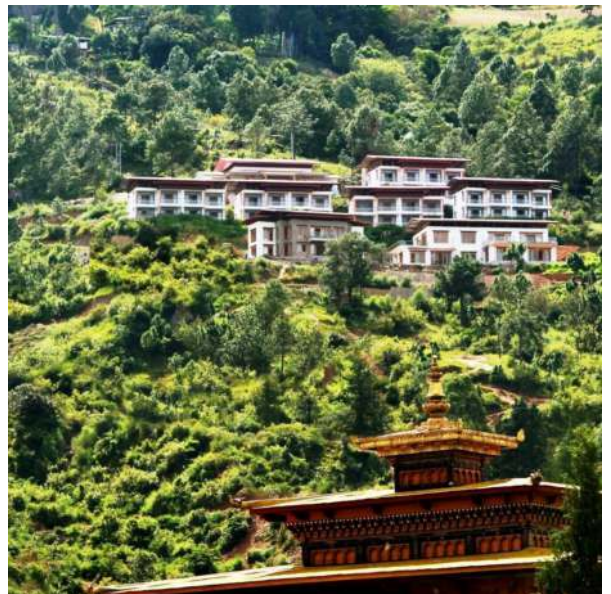


## Day 9 - Farewell to the Kingdom of the Clouds

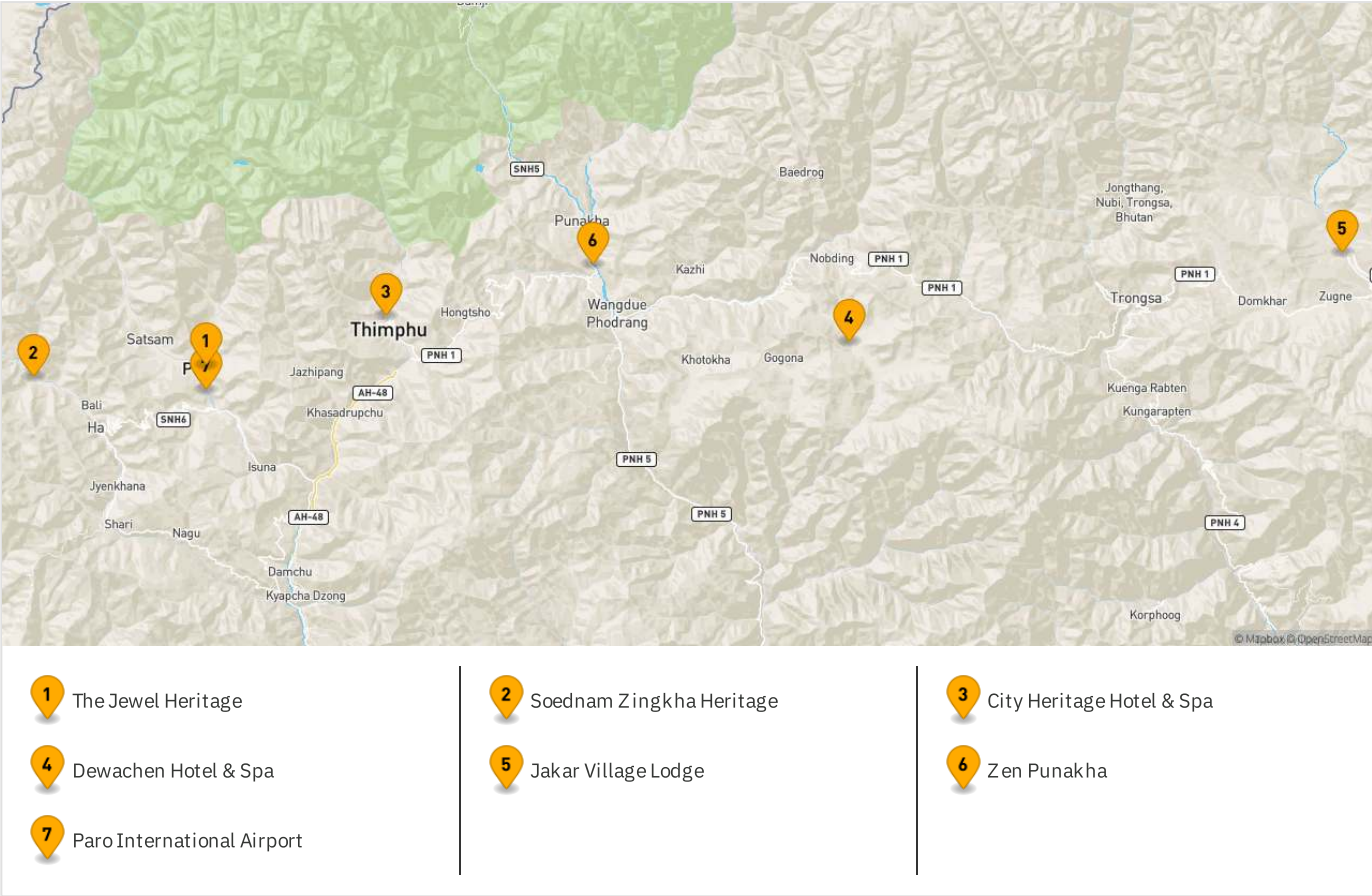
Fri, 20th November 2026
