At the top of the Deer Park lies St. Leonards Lake, our newest lake that forms an essential part of our natural water management system.

C THE DELL

Don't miss the famous Dell for outstanding views across the valley.

The Dell is home to a 35ft Cornish Red Rhododendron planted in the 1800s.

Planted in 1952 to mark the coronation of Queen Elizabeth II.

This garden features many Loderi Rhododendron.

E TOP GARDEN

Once the original site of the Pinetum planted by Sir Edmund Loder, the Top Garden now consists of a collection of many different species of conifer.

F LODERI GARDEN

With a magical feel, this is the oldest part of the garden, with large old rhododendrons, giant conifers & hidden palm trees.

Worth a detour for rhododendron enthusiasts.

Our Pinetum is planted with dozens of rare, unusual and exotic conifers from around the world and is a great place to explore and enjoy the views across the deer park.
